REGULATIONS OF CHOICE CLUB

Club Guests are kindly asked to get acquainted with the following list of regulations.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

1. Purchasing an entry ticket, making a reservation and entering the club premises is equivalent to accepting its regulations.
2. In order to provide our guests with safety and comfortable entertainment, Choice Club reserves the right to refuse entry to persons, who:
 - ▼ are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other intoxicants;
 - ▼ behave aggressively
 - ▼ are under 21 years old
3. Smoking in the Club is forbidden, except for specially prepared rooms for smokers.
4. The time of closing the Club is determined by Club management, according to circumstances.
5. Staff of the Club have the right to refuse to serve alcohol to an unsober person. The next step may be asking the person out of the Club.
6. Security Staff and selectors have the right to ask a Club guest to show their ID in order to establish their identity and verify their age.
7. The decision to allow entry to the Club is made by a selector, who has the right to refuse entry to anyone, whose appearance, outfit or behaviour do not correspond to the standards of the Club. A Selector has the right to refuse entry without giving a reason.
8. Priority entry to the club is granted to holders of VIP cards and membership cards of Choice Club.
9. Persons entering the Club voluntarily agree to stay in the area of increased noise.
10. Club Guests are obliged to comply with the requests of the Club Staff.
11. The Club reserves the right to cancel an organized event. In such a case, guests are entitled to a refund for the purchased tickets. Cancellation of the event does not entitle to any other claims.
12. Entrance to the event means gratuitous consent for using the image by the organizer for marketing purposes. The consent is granted for an indefinite period.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

13. Choice Club conducts safety policy by employing qualified security staff and using monitoring.
14. Persons who behave aggressively or pose threat for other Guests will be asked to leave the Club.

15. The Guests who were asked to leave the Club are not entitled to any refund for purchased entry tickets or drinks.
16. It is forbidden to bring into the Club food, beverages, alcohol, narcotics and other objects that may pose a threat for the Club guests.
17. Security Staff members have the right to view the contents of bags and clothes in case of suspicion mentioned in point 16. If such control is denied, the Club reserves the right to refuse entry to the Club.
18. Due to security reasons, security Staff have the right to refuse entry to Club premises if the maximum number of guests is reached.
19. In case of breaking the law, destruction of property or drastic violation of regulations, Club Staff have the right to use prevention measures provided by law in order to ensure safety in the Club.
20. In case of breaching the law, security Staff have the right to hold the delinquent and hand him over to the Police.
21. The perpetrator is responsible for all damage caused in the Club.

CLOAKROOM REGULATIONS:

The following regulations oblige all Guests of the Club.

1. Leaving outerwear in the cloakroom is obligatory.
2. The charge for storing one piece of outerwear is 2 PLN.
3. Losing a cloakroom token should be immediately reported to Club Staff. The left outerwear will be given back after all Guests have left the Club or on the following day at the time indicated by Club Staff. Before reception, the clothes should be described in detail.
4. The charge for losing or damaging a cloakroom token is 20 PLN.
5. If a Guest loses the token, we do not bear responsibility for missing outerwear.
6. The Club does not deposit valuables in the cloakroom and thereby does not bear responsibility for cash and valuables left there (documents, electronic equipment, credit cards etc.)
7. In case of losing a piece of outerwear by the fault of Club Staff, the Guest is entitled to a refund in the amount of 150 PLN.
8. The Club does not bear responsibility for any accessories or other garments (scarves, gloves, caps, tops) left in sleeves or pockets.
9. The outerwear left in the cloakroom, which is not collected on the day of event, is stored there for up to two weeks.
